Judy is Principal Chief of the Wyandot Nation of Kansas. She has devoted her life to teaching others of the Wyandot history and her heritage.

Lyda Conley and her sisters fought to save the Huron Cemetery in Kansas City, Kansas. In 1910 she was the third woman and the first Native American to argue a case before the Supreme Court of the United States.
